Northaw Road East, Cuffley – Crossing Improvements

We are writing to let you know about upcoming improvements to the zebra crossing on Northaw Road East, Cuffley. These improvements aim to make it easier and safer for local people, including children and families travelling to and from Cuffley Primary School, to cross the road.

These works include:

- construction of a new raised zebra crossing
- improvements to the existing traffic calming measures
- installation of an advisory 20 mph school speed limit
- road resurfacing and other associated works

Why are we carrying out these works?

The crossing is located north of the Theobalds Road/Kingsway junction and is used regularly by local residents, particularly children and families travelling to and from Cuffley Primary School. The proposal was supported through a public consultation carried out in April 2026, and all necessary approvals have now been completed.

Planned works

Works are scheduled to start on Monday 17 August and finish on Saturday 29 August. The zebra crossing will be closed for the duration of the works. To keep local people and our workforce safe while these improvements are carried out, access restrictions will be in place along Northaw Road East.

Northhaw Road East will be closed between the southern end of King James Avenue and Cattlegate Road except for access to properties and side roads.

- Travelling **northbound** on Northhaw Road East, you will be able to access Coronation Avenue, Kingsway and Theobalds Road (via Northhaw Road East end), but you will **not be able to access** King James Avenue
- Travelling **southbound** on Northhaw Road East, you will be able to access King James Avenue, but will **not be able to access** Coronation Avenue, Kingsway and Theobalds Road (via Northhaw Road East end)

Please refer to the Works Information Bulletin and accompanying plans.

Between Thursday 27 August and Saturday 29 August, from 8am to 4pm each day, there will be no vehicle access to or from Kingsway, Theobalds Road (via the Northhaw Road East end) and 40-52 Northhaw Road East, except for emergency vehicles. This is to allow us to resurface this section of road. If you need access for your car during this closure period, please park it in one of the local car parks or on an adjacent road.

Access to homes and driveways will be maintained wherever possible throughout the works. The only exception will be during the road resurfacing described above, when temporary restrictions will be required to allow the works to be completed safely and efficiently. Residents affected by these restrictions will still be able to access their properties on foot.

We understand these works may cause some inconvenience. If possible, please consider using alternative routes during the construction period to help reduce congestion. For shorter journeys, walking, wheeling or cycling may be an alternative option. Works are weather dependent and dates may be subject to change.
