26/27-31 APOLOGIES & ANNOUNCEMENTS

Apologies were accepted, for the reasons given, from Cllr C Burrows, Cllr C Omand, and Cllr J Henderson.
No apologies were received from Cllr M Clark.

26/27-32 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

No interests were noted with regards the agenda but should any other conflicts become apparent that they would be raised at the appropriate time in the agenda.

7.02pm Standing Orders were suspended so members of the public could ask questions/make statements to the Council.

26/27-34 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS OF THE PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Parish Council meetings held Thursday 16th July 2026 and Thursday 23rd July 2026, were noted as circulated.

The minutes as presented were duly proposed, seconded and **RESOLVED** by a unanimous show of hands to be a true and accurate record of the meeting.

Minutes were duly signed by the Chair of Council.

Signed copies are noted to be on file and in the Parish Council records at the archive as required.

26/27-35 FINANCE

a) Retrospective Approval of payments July and August 2026

Councillors noted the circulated payment schedule for July and August 2026. Payments 58-77 were paid by BACS through Unity on 31/07/2026 a total of £21,574.86. There were no questions on the payments made.

Payments 78-108 were paid by BACS through Unity on 28/08/2026 a total of £34,902.39. There were no questions on the payments made.



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The payments as noted would be confirmed within these minutes. Payments were duly proposed, seconded, and unanimously **RESOLVED** by a show of hands.
Motions carried.

b) Delegated authority for September and October 2026 payments

Delegated authority was given to the Clerk/RFO to make the September payments for Month 6 and for October payments for Month 7. This was subject to sign off by the RFO and two councillors prior to payment and that payment sheets would be retrospectively approved at the November 2026 meeting.

This motion was duly proposed, seconded, and unanimously **RESOLVED** by a show of hands.

c) Training Budget Increase Request

A report was considered relating to a budget increase request for Councillor and Officer training.

MOTION:

The Council resolves to transfer £500 from EMR 336 Contingency into the Councillor training budget and £1,600 from EMR 336 Contingency into the Staff training budget.

The motion was duly proposed, seconded, and unanimously **RESOLVED** by a show of hands.

Motion carried.

d) Routine payments for approval

A list of routine payments for 2026/2027 were presented to Council for review, in accordance with Financial Regulation 6.5.

MOTION:

The Council authorises the list of regular payments provided, due in relation to continuing contracts or obligations.

The motion was duly proposed, seconded, and unanimously **RESOLVED** by a show of hands, that the list of regular payments be authorised.

COMMUNITY GRANT APPLICATION

To review, approve and award expenditure to a grant application received for Community Grants 2026/27.

There is £12,500 allocated in the 2026/2027 budget for Community Grants.

Papers sent to Councillors only as they contain financial and operational information but redacted papers available on request.

a) Sowing Seeds Preschool – requesting £5,000.00

Item was deferred until there has been an opportunity to advertise the availability of community grants for 2026-2027, to allow other organisations to apply on equal terms.

LANDOWNER & LEGAL MATTERS

- a) A report was considered relating to the recent Oak Processional Moth infestation at KGV

MOTION:

Council resolves to retrospectively approve the specialist removal of the Oak Processionary Moth (OPM) nests from the KGV Playing Field at a cost of £6,000 plus VAT. Council further concurs that the circumstances comprised an urgent health and safety matter, presenting a significant risk to both members of the public and Council officers, and constituted such an emergency to justify the expenditure under NCPC Financial Regulation 5.3.

MOTION:

The Council approves the noted expenditure required to purchase 16 bird boxes, suitable for nesting Blue Tits, and subsequent installation.

The above motions were taken en bloc and were duly proposed, seconded, and unanimously **RESOLVED** by a show of hands.

Motion carried.

- b) A report was considered relating to vehicle parking on Northaw Green.

MOTION:

That the Council requests officers to investigate their proposed options for the provision of warning signs at Northaw Village Green, and to bring a report setting out the options and recommendations to a future meeting of the Council for consideration.

This motion did not gain a seconder and therefore the motion was not passed.

Motion not carried.

- c) A report was considered relating to the completion of the required Tree works detailed in the Maydencroft tree survey carried out in January 2025.

MOTION:

Council resolves to proceed with the quotation provided, from the Council's Arborist, for the recommended tree safety works at the amount of £2,220.00, and that delegated authority be given to the Clerk to manage and oversee the project.

The motion was duly proposed, seconded, and unanimously **RESOLVED** by a show of hands, that the remaining safety works from the 25/26 tree survey be completed.

Motion carried.

- d) A report was considered relating to a proposal to continue the monitoring of the boundary wall in the Millennium Garden.

MOTION:

The Council agrees to reinstate routine monitoring on the boundary wall in Millennium Gardens, (to be agreed at either 6 month or 12 monthly intervals)



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at a cost of £ 840 to set up markers and then a routine cost of £ 380 for further visits, with delegated authority given to the Clerk to manage and oversee the project.

The motion was duly proposed, seconded, and unanimously **RESOLVED** by a show of hands, that the monitoring on the boundary wall in Millennium Gardens be reinstated at a 12 monthly interval.

- a) A report was considered relating to the appointment of a specialist planning consultant to draft a Reg 19 Local Plan consultation response on behalf of the Council.

MOTION:

That the Council resolves to appoint a planning consultant to produce a response, on behalf of the Parish Council, with delegated authority for these arrangements given to the Clerk.

The motion was duly proposed, seconded, and unanimously **RESOLVED** by a show of hands, and a suitable specialist planning consultant will be appointed.

PARISH ADMINISTRATION

Office Manager's report

To note a verbal or written report from the Clerk of the meeting to include the following items for debate, discussion and instruction as required:

- a) Clerk of the meeting's report
- Northaw War memorial has achieved listed status, and is now listed at Grade II.
 - Due to visible bowing of the top support, the swings at KGV have been inspected and found to be safe.
There is no ability to gain a warranty repair, at this time, as the warranty only covers rot and decay as opposed to not cracking.
The ropes on the basket swing are in the process of being replaced.
 - The start of the football season at KGV had to be delayed, for safety reasons, due to the recent drought conditions.
Fixtures will recommence from 12th September.
Permission has been given for the Football Club to repair the barrier around the senior pitch.
 - The rededication of the WL Robinson VC memorial in Millennium Gardens on 3rd September went very well and was well received by the guests.



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Thanks were given to Paola Munns and the library volunteers, Peter Dace, and the Council staff for all their efforts on the day and in the run up to the event.

There was a request from the Chair that specific thanks to the Office Manager be minuted, regarding the arrangements for the event.

- It was noted that, following previous water ingress, some redecoration work had been carried out by the landlord in the back areas of the Parish Office. Updates on further leak detection work, regarding the current ingress, are awaited.
- An update was given on the application of the 2026 pay award for local government employees regarding council staff.
- Councillors were asked to send any issues experienced with the current Zoho email system to the office manager, as soon as possible, so that an associated report could be brought to the next meeting regarding changing providers.
- Councillors were asked to pass on their availability to the office manager regarding an invitation to attend an official opening for the Northaw Road East crossing.
- The next meeting was reconfirmed as 11th November 2026 with a deadline for motions or papers being 23rd October.

- b) Approval was given for the inclusion of a page of contact details for local non-profit or charity organisations in Update magazine from issue 91 (March 2026), with the administration, and updating, of these contacts to be delegated to the NCRA.

The motion was duly proposed, seconded, and unanimously **RESOLVED** by a unanimous show of hands

- c) The date of the Christmas Lighting ceremony switch on was confirmed as Friday 27th November 2026. Cllr Brian Seegar was asked, and agreed, to act as celebrant.
